

Documentation required when applying for a **STUDY** visa to travel to Ireland

**PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL DOCUMENTS LISTED BELOW MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR APPLICATION
INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

All documents must be in English (or be accompanied by a notarised translation with the name of the translator and their contact details)

Important Notes

- All letters should be dated within the four week period immediately prior to your application date
- The Visa Officer reserves the right to request additional documentation, if required, in support of your application
- The provision of all of the documentation listed does not guarantee that a visa will be granted

Passport(s):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your original passport, valid for at least 12 months after your date of departure from Ireland with at least 2 blank visa pages • If you hold other passports, or have held previous passports, you must also submit them, along with a full colour copy with your application.
